Dear Hunter,

Thank you for requesting information regarding the annual disabled person turkey hunt on the Bois D'Arc Conservation Area. This hunt is intended for applicants that are non-ambulatory or with a permanent disability severe enough to prohibit their ability to hunt unassisted.

The hunt will take place on April 28 and 29, 2012

**Fill out and return the enclosed form postmarked no later than March 15, 2012. This will officially enter you for the hunt. Should more hunters apply than available blinds, a random drawing will be held on March 16, 2012 and the successful hunters will be notified shortly thereafter.**

1. Applicants must provide a statement of eligibility from a physician to verify the applicant's overall physical condition is such that they may participate without further endangering their health and the level of paralysis, amputation, or permanent disability must be stated in the statement to verify extent of the applicant's condition. The physician's letter must be on an official letterhead with an original signature.

***\*\*\*NOTE: All Candidates MUST certify with their physician for this hunt\*\*\****

2. Each hunter and volunteer assistant must be Hunter Education Certified if they are born on or after January 01, 1967 and have the proper hunting permit to participate.
3. You will be notified by March 25, 2012 if you have been selected, and to give you final details including the mandatory pre hunt clinic which will be held at the Dalton Range on April 7, 2012.
