Thank you assisting the applicant with his/her statement of eligibility.

The Bois D'Arc Conservation Area Disabled Person Turkey Hunt is to provide a recreational opportunity to a special group of Missouri's population that are non-ambulatory or with a permanent disability severe enough to prohibit their ability to hunt unassisted. These individuals are fully capable of properly using a firearm to hunt game, but have restricted ability to access land for a quality hunting experience. This plan is an effort to provide proper access, facilities, and other needed resources so these individuals can enjoy a safe and successful recreational experience as most other individuals in our state.

The applicant should fill out Section A. They should have signed and dated the statement of eligibility above permittee's signature and date in Section A.

You should fill out section B. Please sign and date the statement of eligibility as indicated on the form.
